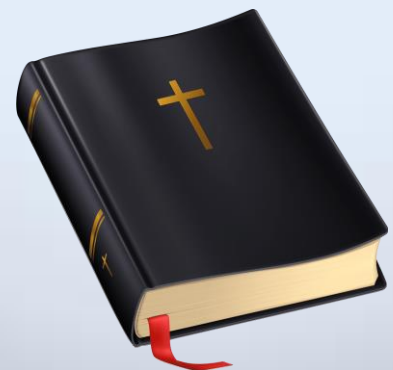
CHILD SAFETY MEETING
